Travel Health Insurance

Travel Health Insurance required by the Organizing Committee

The Organizing Committee requires purchasing international health coverage. The event's official travel agency offers an insurance plan that has international coverage for hospitalizations for Covid19, as well as coverage for other medical needs, incidents or accidents while traveling to the event.

The 8-day coverage plan costs USD 75 and 14-day coverage costs USD 125 (plan type: ACR 60 + Covid19).

To purchase the travel health insurance or detailed information, please send a request to the Organizing Committee at regata@remobrasil.com, while confirming accommodation reservations.

Team's own Travel Health Insurance

If your team prefers to use their own travel health insurance, you must be sure that this plan has international coverage for treatment and hospitalization by Covid19 in Rio de Janeiro and is applied to all team members.

The team's insurance plan contract should be sent to covid@remobrasil.com, according to the COVID-19 - Protection Plan and regulations applied for this event.

Paralympic Classification Panel

The classification panel will be carried out according to the information below:

Panel date: March 3

Location: Functional assessment room, next to the Boat House located at Venue

Transportation to the classification panel: according to the scheduling of the shuttle by the teams. We request to check the transport schedule of the athlete and respective accompanying person on March 2 until 1p.m., with the transport office at transport@remobrasil.com.

Covid19 Protocol: the panel will strictly follow the protocol for the prevention of contagion by Covid19. The athlete and respective accompanying person must wear a new disposable mask at the time of the panel and perform cleaning before entering the room. The room will be sanitized at each new assessment, as well as any change in protective equipment.

Only athletes who are competing in the qualifier and who have previously submitted a request for classification will be classified. The classification panel schedule will be sent to the Member Federations involved by World Rowing, prior to the day of the panel.
