LUCAS VERTHEIN

UNPRECEDENTED GOLD AT THE PANAMERICAN GAMES IN SANTIAGO 2023

Lucas Verthein literally closes the 2023 international season with a flourish at the Pan American Games in Santiago 2023. Our athlete, after a silver medal in the Pre-Pan American, held at the beginning of this year, and having participated in two World Cups and World Cup, wins another's medal and climbs to the highest place on the podium in Laguna Grande, breaking a 36-year fast!

Lucas's medal is unprecedented for Brazilian rowing: the first gold medal in individual events! The athlete accumulates milestones in his career, third place in the Junior World Cup in 2016, best place in the Olympics in Single Skiff, gold medal at the Pan American Games and all this at just 25 years old.

Lucas Verthein writes his name in the history of national rowing with one of the best

skiffists in the history of national rowing, if not the best, but if you think the rower will stop there, he won't! The leader in the national ranking, who won four gold medals in the last Brazilian championships, is already making plans for the pre-Olympics that will take place in March, next year, in Rio de Janeiro.

"This result represents everything. It represents a milestone in the history of our Brazilian rowing, the beginning of a new story. Thank you for living this moment, for everyone who was involved in this victory. Everyone who can be together with us, believing in this gold. It's historic, it's for Brazil and it's everything.

Now I want more, I want Paris. I want the Olympic medal and everyone will be working hard, just like me", declared our post-victory athlete in an interview with Team Brasil. We here, continue to support Lucas Verthein and all the our athletes! Always following together for more!!

3.1 UNIFIED YOUNG TALENT CBI



More than 200 athletes registered, 21 clubs planned from four of the five regions of Brazil. Young athletes up to 18 years old, divided into three categories by age, to compete in the youngest championship on the Brazilian calendar in 22 events with scheduled qualifiers. Four days of competition on Ilha do Pavão, at the GNU nautical headquarters.

When everything was organized and planned, referees called, boats on the way, medals and trophies ready, the rains in Porto Alegre returned with everything and the Guaíba River, once again, showed its strength and invaded the GNU headquarters for the second time in the year! What makes the championship unviable on the water now? The only way found, to not cancel the CBI of Young Talents, by the CBR, represented by its President Magali Moreira, and GNU, in the person of Rowing Technical Director Marcellus Marsilli, was to transform the format of the event to indoor.

Then begins the second round of negotiations with the clubs involved. Many coaches did not want the indoor format and preferred not to take their teams.

There were days of a lot of conversation, negotiation where the role of the President of the CBR was fundamental in convincing the teams to adhere to the idea, since cancelling the Young Talents would be much worse for the sport. After all, what athlete doesn't like to compete?

The teams' participation was almost 100%, only two decided not to go, and in the end we had a full CBI of Young Talents, with athletes from all over the country and no competitions canceled! At the same time as the negotiations were going on, the GNU team, together with RemoSul, took the remergometers to the Club's headquarters in Moínhos and prepared the competition venue to receive our rowers, with the integrated start and finish system and the big screen which simulated boats evolving in the lane as the athletes performed.

Referees, called up for the traditional Young Talents, adapted to the new competition format, the relief teams were in place and ready to work. Machines lined up for the tests and more machines in another area for the athletes to warm up.

The 19 teams that attended and made rowing experience one of the best moments of this season, thank you very much:

Paysandu, Guajará, São Salvador, GNU, GPA, Paulistano, Corinthians, América, Pinheiros, Península, Centro Português, Flamengo, Vasco, Botafogo, Riachuelo, Águas Cabral, Salkianha da Gama, Acares, CRC and Aldo Luz!

There were four days where the athletes, even indoors, were able to compete in a healthy, safe environment and did what they do best: row, compete and celebrate our sport: Rowing! We also count on the broadcast of the YouTube channel Histórias de Remador, which also joined the idea of Remo Indoor and was present during the four days of competition.

What we saw was the integration of teams, athletes leaving everything on the machines, very tough races, tight finishes and a lot of determination and resilience from these kids who are the future of Brazilian rowing! And this base is strong. Very strong!!! Our sincere thanks to the clubs that came to Jovens Talentos 2023 and believed in the work of CBR and GNU!

3.2 CBI OF SHORT AND LONG BOATS

The knockout phase in the Brazilian Interclub Championship began on July 26th. Athletes from all over Brazil attended Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas for the main national Olympic Rowing competition of the 2023 season. More than 200 rowers defending their clubs from more than 10 Brazilian states.

The program featured 67 long and short boat races, and in different age and weight categories. Lagoa was the scene of highly contested races. On Thursday, June 29th, the finalists were defined. Friday (30), Saturday (01) and Sunday (02), the finals of all events were played, resulting in a medal and the title of Brazilian champion 2023.

3.3 PADDLE CBI

Eight events on the program to define the best in each category and boat in the Brazilian Para Rowing Championship.
For Athletes from all over Brazil gathered at the Olympic lane at Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas, in the capital of Rio de Janeiro. Flamengo was the grand champion of the event, taking four events, Aldo Luz was runner-up.

There were fifteen clubs showing that Brazil is developing Para-Remo. The sport becomes more competitive every day. Bahia, Espírito Santo, Pernambuco, Rio Grande do Sul, Rio de Janeiro, São Paulo and Santa Catarina were very well represented in this Brazilian Rowing Championship.

Well-known names in the category such as

World champion of the II World Cup, held in Varese, Josiane Lima attended the Brazilian championship. Josi won the women's PR2 single time World sculls in her race, (1x PR2). Two-time Champion Jairo Klug and our super champion Claudia Santos also competed in the event and did well, defending the colors of Pinheiros de São Paulo.

The PR3 mixed double sculls (2x PR3 Mix), silver medalist twice at the Varese World Cup and the Czech Republic World Cup formed by Valdeni da Silva Júnior and Diana Barcelos also attended, defending the colors of Flamengo, and won the gold medal in their event.

3.4 BRAZILIAN MASTER CHAMPIONSHIP

There were 300 athletes, from 19 clubs, fighting for medals! The first teams are already in the Country's Capital making final preparations for the Brazilian Masters Championship. On the first day of competition, Odilon Maia Martins from Aldo Luz, made his debut at this Brazilian Championship. The most experienced, active rower in the world didn't run away from the fight!!! The first athlete in the M category at the World Rowing Championships shows that he is up to date with his training!

Anyone who didn't go to this Brazilian Rowing Championship, which took place in Brasília, missed a great Rowing celebration! Now only next year! Congratulations to Minas Brasília for the championship, to Corinthians for second place and to Crossrowing for third place!!!

Thank you to the clubs and athletes who participated from the north to the south of the country!!! You guys rocked it!

3.5 II RIO INTERNATIONAL REGATTA

The second edition of the Rio International Regatta was held in June at Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas. Four events were part of the event that brought together South American countries to promote and develop Para-Rowing on the continent, with a view to the Paris Games taking place this year. Brazil was the highlight of the event, winning three of the four events!

The competition is part of the World Rowing Para Camp activities that took place in parallel to the RIR.

In the men's PR1 single sculls (M1x PR1), our representative Igor Batista won his race. Followed by Pedro Lescano, from Uruguay, in second and José Duarte, from Paraguay, in third. Ecuador also competed in the race, represented by Ober Colobom, coming fourth.

In the women's PR1 single sculls (F1x PR1) our super champion, Claudia Santos, took the gold medal. Argentina rower Pilar Jensen won the silver medal.

In the third race of the day PR3, the double skiff mixed (2x PR3 Mix) there was a Brazilian double. The Brazilian duo formed by Renan Barreto and Angel Santos came first. Followed by the guanição, also Brazilians, André Duarte and Ana Madruga. The bronze medal went to Yanira Carrasco and Carlos Rodriguez from Peru.

On the same descent as the double, PR3 athlete from Uruguay, Christian Morales, accepted the challenge and competed in the men's PR3 single sculls (M1x PR3), taking home the gold medal.

4.1 I and II WORLD CUP - Olympic Team

Athlete Lucas Verthein (Botafogo) is our representative at the I World Cup of the 2023 season, which took place in Zagreb, Croatia, between the 5th and 7th of May.

The rower competed in the men's single sculls (M1x). Our athlete finished this competition in first place in final C. By very little, 0.12 hundredths of a second, our Lucas Verthein was left out of the fight for medals in the quarter finals. The finish was defined in the photo finish.

The II World Cup was held between the 16th and 18th of June, in Varese, Italy. The traditional competition takes place all year round, always divided into three stages, in accordance with World Rowing regulations. Lucas Verthein and Beatriz Tavares were our representatives in the single sculls (1x) in their respective genres.

Our athletes faced this challenge, as another stage, in the preparation for the Pan American Games in Santiago 2023, which takes place at the end of the year. Bia Tavares came third in the C final of her race, taking fifteenth place overall. A good position and a great learning experience that will make our athlete seek even more and improve her race strategies and tactics.

Our athlete Lucas Verthein went to the race with the largest number of entries in the competition: 38. The II World Cup saw the participation of 42 countries, some of which entered boats A and B in the evidences.

Lucas was coming from thirteenth place in the first stage of the same competition and the Varese World Cup would be his thermometer to check the evolution of his performance.

Our athlete not only showed that he belongs among the best in the world, but also that all his effort and dedication are bearing fruit.

The Brazilian rower had a brilliant competition and came second in the B final of the event, eighth place overall. The athlete was the only representative from the American continent to reach the A/B semi finals of this World Cup, with the right to break a personal record in his semi. Unfortunately, because of two seconds, Lucas did not advance to the A final, leaving all of us in the crowd wanting more and with the certainty that our athlete will bring great achievements to Brazilian Rowing!

“Once again, it is a great feeling of gratitude for living this moment and preparing myself strongly for the World Cup, the Pan American Games and Paris. Now, it's focus on focus. It's a tough stop. As Bruno Fratus would say, 'they are great, but we are bad!'", says Lucas Verthein.

4.2 PRE-PANAMERICAN SANTIAGO



In April, our team went to Chile to fight for medals and places in the Pan American Games Qualification Regatta. We were represented by 19 athletes and will compete in 11 events in the program. There are 16 countries and more than 200 rowers registered for this event.

The Panamerican Qualification Regatta, Pre Pan, was held between the 15th and 19th of April in the San Pedro de La Paz Lagoon, in Chile! Remembering this competition is worth a place in the Pan American Games.



On the first day of the qualifiers, excitement took over San Pedro de la Paz, Chile. The rowers, members of the Copare Athletes Commission, organized a minute of silence in honor of Cuban Angel Fournier, three-time Pan American single sculls champion (M1x), who died this year in March.

Our athletes did not disappoint and brought three medals to Brazil and we classified 10 of the 11 boats registered.

The women's four sculls (4xF) was the first Brazilian boat to reach the podium, qualifying for Santiago 2023 and the bronze medal.

Thanks girls.

Bia Tavares was a warrior and fought until the end, remaining constant in third position, without losing sight of the race leaders. Lucas led until the end, unfortunately the gold didn't come, but he brought us the silver medal. Two athletes who promise more emotions and pride for this Pan American 2023.

4.3 JUNIOR ROWING WORLD

Our athletes from the Brazilian U19 Team embark today (30), for the World Rowing Championship, which was held between the 2nd and 6th of August in Paris! The super Daniel Passold (America) represents us in the men's single sculls (M1x) and the incredible Ana Julia Ferreira (Flamengo) and Brenda Madruga (Centro Português) in the women's double sculls (W2-).

The work and training were supervised by Technician Roque Zimmermann. The event is a test of facilities for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.

With very tough races in a lane with a lot of wind, waves and rain, our braves end their participation in Final C of the World Rowing U19 World Cup.

The weather and streak conditions, caused by very strong side winds, delayed the World Cup events by one day. World Rowing, after the Technical Congress, decided to postpone the start of the U19 World Cup until the 3rd!

Our girls Brenda Madruga and Ana Julia Ferreira won their final and finished in thirteenth place overall. Our boy Daniel Passold finished his Final C in second and fourteenth place overall in the competition.

Congratulations to the athletes for their resilience and persistence and to Coach Roque Zimmermann for his tireless support for our athletes!!

4.4 WORLD ROWING UNDER 23

Brazil ends the U23 World Cup with three boats among the 10 best in the world!

Our João Vinicius Ferreira (Vasco) had the best place among Brazilians and is the seventh best in the world! Winning your final! There were more than 30 countries participating in this World Cup, organized by World Rowing! More than 200 athletes from the under-23 category met in Plovdiv, Bulgaria.

The lightweight double skiff formed by Pedro Xavier (GNU) and Marcelo Almeida (Botafoogo) did well and arrived in



second in his final, setting the eighth best time in the World Cup. What an end to the race!!!!

Our other pair, Tomás Levy (Corinthians) and Breno Ornellas (Flamengo) finished their race in fourth, taking tenth position overall! Brazil ends its participation in the U23 World Cup in Plovdiv, Bulgaria, organized by World Rowing with the three boats among the 10 best in the world. Thanks so much boys!!!

4.5 SENIOR ROWING WORLD

More than 900 athletes from 74 countries meet in the Serbian capital, Belgrade, at the World Championships organized by World Rowing. In

addition to the fight for medals, this was the first opportunity for athletes from all over the world to win a place to compete in the Paris 2024 Games, the Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The Brazilian team was made up of seven athletes in five boats. Lucas Verthein is our

representative in Olympic rowing and goes all out in the men's single sculls (M1x), an event with the highest number of entries in the competition: 48.

Our athlete did everything, but finished the World Cup in first place in the C final.

In the Paralympics, our athletes Claudia Santos and René Pereira represent us in the PR1 single sculls of their respective genders. Claudinha made history by qualifying for the Paralympic Games for the fifth time. Our PR1 representative becomes the only Brazilian athlete with

participation in five Games and the only one that won its place in this World Cup. Oui, let's have Brazil in Paris!!!

In the PR2 mixed double skiff (PR2 x Mix) it was the turn of the duo Gessyca Guerra and Leandro Sagaz to go to battle and make their debut in the World Championships. In this race, six boats qualified for Paris 2024. Our boat finished in the B final of the event and, therefore, did not qualify. Having another chance next year in Lucerne.

In the PR3 category, our two-time world champions Diana Barcellos and Jairo Klug row to win one of the five places for the Paralympics. This event is the big news of the program that will make its debut at the Paris 2024 Games. Our athletes went to final A, fought until the end, but finished sixth, also moving on to try to qualify in Lucerne.

The World Rowing Championships continued until September 10th, at the Ada Ciganlija track, in Belgrade. Congratulations to the super Claudinha! See you in Paris!!!

4.6 SOUTH AMERICAN JUNIOR AND UNDER23



After the emotions of the Pre-Pan

American, it was the turn of the South American Under 23 and Junior Championships to take place in San Pedro de La Paz, Chile. Our selection made up of 12 athletes promises to come with everything!!!

Brazil competes in 12 events on the

program. "The competitions take place from 9:00 am, Brasilia time.

According to information from the event organizers, after the Technical Congress, all races are confirmed and the finals will be held with up to seven boats. For this reason, the number of qualifiers was reduced.

"Of the seven events contested by Brazil, on the first day of the finals, we reached the podium in five of them. There were two gold medals with

Piedro Xavier (1x) and Daniel Passold (1x), two silver medals with the two without

helmsman (2-) by Facundo Mezquita and Daniel Lima and the four sculls (4x) by Helen Belony, Lara Pizarro, Maria Shatiane Ucker and Thalita Soares.

In addition to the bronze medal in the two without (2-) of Shaine Ucker and Mariana Macedo, Helen Belony (BW 1x), Piedro Xavier (BM1x),

Marcelo Barbosa and João Ferreira (BLM2x) won three silver medals on the second day of finals at the South American Championship in San Pedro de La Paz. This Championship, organized by CSAR, features more than 140 athletes from eight countries, in a program with 27 events.

4.7 CUP AMERICA COASTAL ROWING

At the beginning of May, between the 1st and 11th, World Rowing held the Second Copa América de Remo Costal in Lima, Peru. Thirteen countries and more than 120 athletes met on Chorrillos beach to find out who the best teams on the Continent are. The competition was divided into three stages: Beach

Sprint, 6 and 23 kilometer crossing. Our

athletes competed in all disciplines and brought home four medals! This was the best Brazilian campaign in the sport.

they were proud of the medals, posture, unity and competitive spirit.

Vangelys Reinke and Bárbara Santos opened the count on the first day of the medal dispute, at the Beach Sprint. The two rowers took the podium and won the first Brazilian medal in the history of this coastal discipline, bringing home the bronze in a race defined in the last meters in the mixed double sculls boat (C2xMix).

The last phase of the competition is the hardest and longest, the 23 kilometer crossing. Our trio of Brazilians Herbert, Vangelys, Bárbara, joined the Uruguayan if Romina Cetraro and the Peruvian Santiago Seminario (helmsman) in the four skiff boat with mixed helmsman (C4x Mix+). The five athletes won the silver medal in a fantastic race and finished to the delight of the spectators.

With just three athletes, the Brazilian team returns with a more than positive result from the Second Copa América de Remo Costal. Vangelys Reinke (Flamengo), Herbert Berckenhagen (Bandeirantes) and Bárbara Paz (Paysandú) overcame obstacles in and out of the water and into the

The Brazilian women's and men's double sculls reached final A and finished their races in sixth and fifth place respectively and the eight with mixed coxswain, debuting in the Pan American rowing program, also came in fifth place.

Honorable mention for our "balls on the beam", boats that fought until the end and finished in four places, the two in coxswain and the women's four sculls and the lightweight men's double sculls that we vibrated and suffered with them left us with a great taste I want more.

On the second day of competition, it was the turn of Barbara Santos (Paysandu), directly from Pará, invading the land of Shakira, to win the Bronze medal in CW1x!! One more for the count! Brazilian Rowing was very well represented at the V Odesur Beach Games in Santa Marta, Colombia!!

There were days of intense competition, with arrivals that excited the crowd.

The brave Beto Berck (Bandeirante) and Vangelys Reinke (Flamengo) take Brazil to the podium in the first Beach Sprint race in Santa Marta! The Brazilian duo got the better of Paraguay in CM2x!!!

In the days following the tests, two balls hit the post. Our athletes left everything in the water, but unfortunately there was no podium. The rowing team ended its participation in Santa Marta with a feeling of accomplishment, but with a feeling of wanting more.

4.10 WORLD COASTAL ROWING

Between the 29th of September and the first of October, World Rowing held the World Coastal Rowing Championships in Bartletta, Italy. The event registered a record number of participants: 137 boats from 39 countries.

Remo Brasil was very well represented by the super experienced and medalists in Santa Marta Vangelys Reinke (Flamengo) and Herbert Berckenhagen (Bandeirante). The female part of the Selection comes with new features! The debutant in backstroke is none other than our Rio 2016 representative, Fernanda Nunes (Vasco).

Beach Sprint: While Beto faced 34 boats in his men's single coastal sculls (CM1x), the duo Vangelys and Fernanda competed against 27 boats in the mixed double coastal sculls (CMix 2x).

In the mixed event, our boat was left out of the final stage by just 0.02 seconds and in the



men's classification heat in the final for our Beto, who was just 2 seconds behind first place.

The top eight in each heat passed to the next phase. Our athletes barely reach the World Cup Knock Offs.

6k Crossing: On the last day (08) of the Coastal World Cup, how did we end up? Vibrating together with our athletes!!! Vangelys Reinke (Flamengo) and Fernanda Nunes (Vasco) are the sixth best in the world in the Endurance C2xMIX race.

After a collision, normal in Endurance races, our athletes fell a little in position but recovered, putting on an incredible race! In the other Final A that we participated in, the brave Beto Berck (Bandeirante) and Vangelys Reinke came eleventh in the C2xM race.

4.12 II WORLD CUP - Paralympic Team

The II World Cup was held between the 16th and 18th of June, in Varese, Italy. The traditional competition takes place all year round, always divided into three stages, in accordance with World Rowing regulations, The Brazilian Para-Rowing Team reached the podium three times and placed Brazil among the top 10 in the medals table.

The Brazilian Para-Rowing was very well represented by our team made up of 10 athletes and participated in five events, The result for the CBR Technical Committee was more than positive.

PR3: It was from the PR3 category that two medals came, two silver. The first with boat two without a male helmsman (M2- PR3) of Keizy Bonini and Gabriel Mendes who made their debut, wearing the colors of the Brazilian team.

In the category's mixed double sculls race (2x Mix PR3), two Brazilian boats won places in final A of the event. For the first time in the history of rowing in the country, The duo formed by Jairo Klug and Priscila Barreto finished the competition in fifth place overall. Our other team, made up of Diana Barcelos and Valdeni da Silva Júnior, took second place, taking us, once again, to the podium with them. Silver medal for the Brazilian duo.

PR2: In the PR2 category, the planning was changed at the last minute. The CBR Technical Committee wanted to take two PR2 mixed doubles to the event, but Michell Pessanha showed symptoms of Covid-19 and thought it best to spare himself. Leaving his partner, Josiane Lima, alone on the boat.

CBR then adapted its plans, changing Josiane's boat. This way the rower was able to participate in this World Cup. Our athlete made the sacrifice of changing races at the last minute,

rowing the women's single sculls PR2 (W1x PR2), Josiane Lima had a very strong race and led the entire course. Our athlete won the gold medal and climbed to the highest place on the podium.

Our second pair from PR2, Leandro Sagaz and Gessyca Guerra, made a strong repechage but unfortunately lost by a few seconds to the French team.

Our athletes went on to Final B, of the event, and led from start to finish, opening up almost 20 seconds of advantage over second place.

Setting a strong pace for their opponents, Sagaz and Guerra won the B final of the event and finished the competition in seventh overall.

PR1: Our only representative in the category, René Pereira took the single sculls (M1x PR1) for his race. Paralympic bronze medalist in Tokyo, our athlete got his place in the A final of this World Cup.

I talk to God a lot when I'm on the boat", he concludes.

The super Claudia Santos was the first to stamp her passport for Paris 2024 and serves as an inspiration for other athletes in the sport with her life and sporting story.

6.2 OLYMPIC ROWING SELECTION 01 - NATIONAL GROUP DEFINITION



At the beginning of the year, the first selection was held to define the athletes who will represent us at the Pan American Games. It was held between the 22nd and 26th of February at the Olympic track at Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas in Rio de Janeiro. The evaluation in short boats was carried out according to the international progression system and defined the general ranking of male and female rowers in Single Skiff and Two Skiff, according to the CBR Technical Committee.

ranked among the 51 rowers who participated in this selection. According to Caminhos de Seleção, which defines the strategies and programming of the Brazilian Team in the 2023 season, a second tryout is also planned, as well as training camps.

It is worth mentioning that the results of the internal qualification tests were made available in full to coaches participating in the evaluation and who have athletes qualified for this selection

process. The ranking served as criteria for defining the long boat crews for the evaluations of this first selection. The Pan Americano de Santiago in Chile takes place at the end of the year between October 20th and November 5th this year!

This was the first selection to define the National Group that will represent us in the qualifying regatta for the Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile. A group of 23 athletes, 12 women and 11 men, if

6.3 FIRST PADDING CT

In March, the CBR Technical Committee held the first Training Camp for the Paralympic rowing team, in the USP lane.

This was the first meeting of athletes with the new CBR coordinator, Julio Noronha.

"This camp is taking place now, after two control works that took place in January and February, and is helping me to get to know the group that makes up the functional classes and boats that participate in the Paralympic program and were, for this reason, highlighted as priority for this Technical Coordination and the Presidency of CBR", explained Julio.

There were 10 athletes selected in a hybrid group, that is, mixing athletes with more experience and other candidates for vacancies. The system proposed by the CBR Technical Committee for rowers interested in participating in the Brazilian team during the World Cup in Belgrade, which will take place next September, consists of monthly assessments and training camps to conduct and verify the evolution of these athletes.

This Training Camp did not have the objective of selecting the Paralympic team for international competitions. The intention, at this first moment, was to monitor the development of athletes between monthly assessments and define training strategies for the 2023 season.

"The athlete has to seek his evolution and the comparison of his evaluations with himself, that is, improvements from January to February and so on. When selecting and defining the group to represent Brazil in international competitions, we will define the criteria assessments in a clear and transparent manner

6.4 OLYMPIC ROWING SELECTION 02 - NATIONAL RANKING DEFINITION

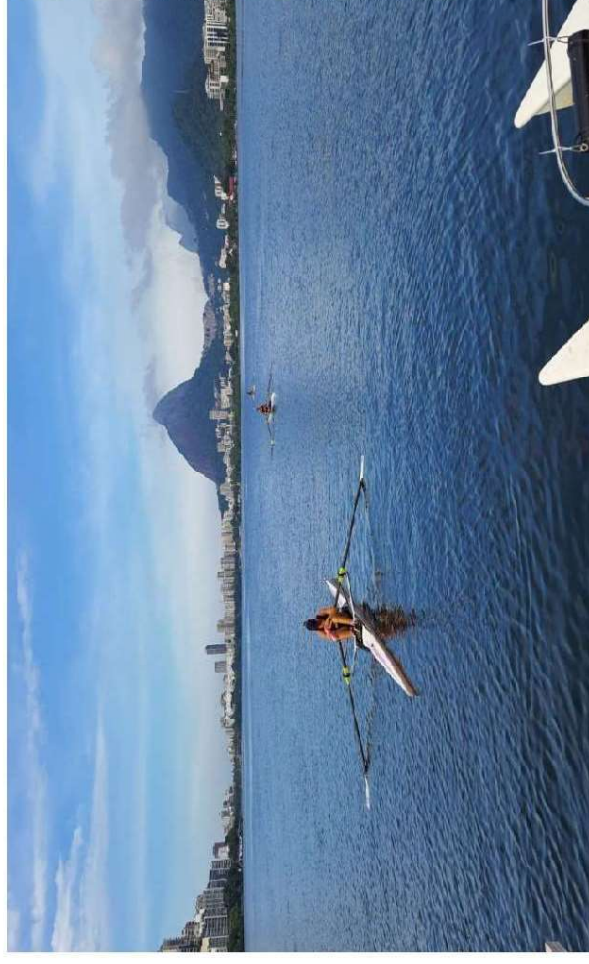
The second Internal Qualification was held at Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas, Rio de Janeiro, at the end of March, to define the places for the short and long boats that will participate in the South American Junior and Under 23 and Pre-Pan Championships.

The national group was defined last month, according to the planning of the CBR Technical Committee. This selection is another stage in the process to define the squads that will make up the Brazilian Team for the 2023 Season.

On the first day of the Selective, the first places for short boats and ranking processes were

defined. The South American Rowing and Pre-Pan Championships took place in April in Conceição, Chile. On the second day of selection, the Internal Qualification continued with its schedule and more single sculls, starting at 9:00 am, at Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas.

Based on the results of this Selective, the National General Ranking was prepared and published by the CBR Technical Committee and the short boat athletes were defined for the Brazilian Team that will represent us at the Pan-American Games held in Santiago, Chile. In the long boats, the National Group went to the CT at GNU, where they trained until the date of the Pan-American, after a third Selective held in Porto Alegre.

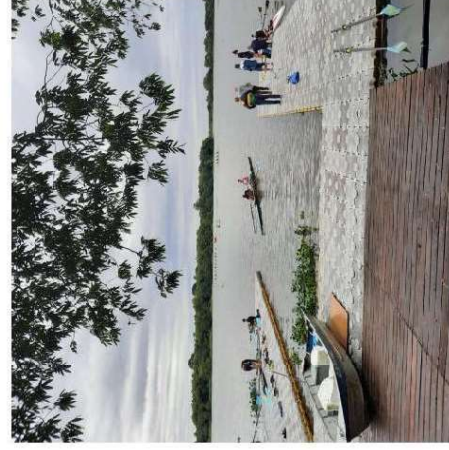
Paralympic Training Center was held on Ilha do Pavao, Grêmio Náutico Uniao in the city of Porto Alegre in April. The objective of the CT was to continue the process of evaluating the formation of boats in the Paralympic Regatta program for the Paris 2024 cycle.

The training provided the basis for the strategies adopted for the first major international competition of the sport in the 2023 Season: The second stage of the World Cup, held in Varese Italy. Organized by World Rowing.

Twelve para-athletes were evaluated by the CBR Technical Committee formed by Cesar Augusto Silva, Fernando Carvalho and Frédéric Mallrich Jr. In addition to the Confederation's Technical Coordinator Julio Noronha.

From this Training Center the boats for the World Cup were decided and for the first time in the history of the sport in Brazil, CBR took two boats from Category PR2 and PR3 to the competition.

"After the Varese World Cup, we will change the formation of the boats and test them again in the Gaviratte International Regatta, also held in Italy. The idea is to look for the best combination of athletes for the definitive formations on the boat that will seek the places paralympics at the World Cup in Serbia at the end of the year, explained Julio Noronha, paralympic rowing coordinator at CBR.

7.4 PARALYMPIC AWARD - CPB

The most traditional Award in Brazilian Paralympic sport took place in São Paulo, at the beginning of 2024, and honors athletes from 24 sports who were highlighted on the national and international scene.

In Rowing, the 2023 Paralympic Trophy went to our representative in Tokyo 2021, Diana Barcelos, who in 2023 was two-time Brazilian Champion, sixth place in the World Cup alongside Jairo Klug, and second place in the II World Cup alongside Valdeci da Silva Junior.

“When I talk about this award I get emotional. It is the materialization of a year of a lot of dedication, a lot of effort. Sport has sometimes good results, other times, not so much. We already had the opportunity to get a second place for Brazil at the Paris Paralympic Games, for a position not

we achieved. Now we will have another chance in Switzerland next year to get our passport stamped, says Diana”

“It is extremely important to be here, today, rewarding the best athletes of 2023, a historic year for Brazilian Paralympic sport. We returned from the Parapan American Games in Santiago with a record number of medals. Today is the day to toast all that the athletes did in 2023 and give a taste of what could come in 2024 in the next Paralympic Games”, declared the vice-president of the CPB, Yohansson Nascimento.

This Friday (15th) it is COB's turn to honor the best of the year at the Brasil Olimpico award, which reaches its 24th edition in Cidade das Artes, Rio de Janeiro, broadcast on Canal Olimpico.

7.5 BRAZIL OLYMPIC AWARD - COB

The 24th edition of the Brazil Olimpico Award crowned the country's best athletes in the 2023 season. The ceremony promoted by the Brazilian Olympic Committee (COB) was held in Cidade das Artes, West Zone of Rio de Janeiro.

In Remo, the big winner of the night was Lucas Verthein Ferreira (Botafogo). The rower had a brilliant season, breaking a 36-year absence from the sport, bringing the long-awaited gold medal at the Pan American Games. The men's single sculls (M1x) achieved this first in their competition.

Lucas also led the national ranking during the tryouts, achieving important placements in international competitions throughout the year and won four gold medals during the Unified Rowing CBI, achieving 100% success in his events.

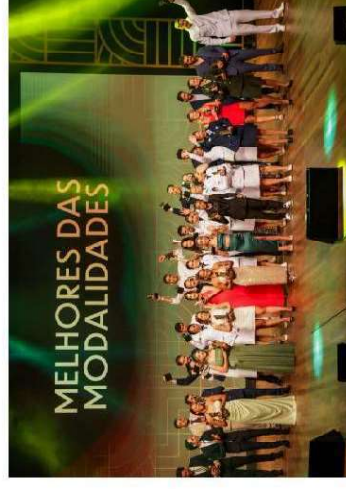
Always focused on the challenges of the following year, Lucas, shortly after winning the Pan-American gold medal, was already talking about his plans for the Paris Olympic qualification and improving his performance during the World Cups and World Cups. The rower is a South American rowing champion and won the bronze medal in 2016 at the World Rowing Championships, held in the Netherlands.

In memoriam: At a time to celebrate the history and lives of great sports personalities who left us in 2023, the Olympic Committee

Brazilian paid a beautiful tribute to the

Olympic athletes José Carvalho and Nilton Alonço, known as Gaúchinho.

The Brasil Olimpico award also made mention of Brazil's performance at the Pan-American Games. Held in Santiago, Chile. The team won 205 medals and finished second overall. In the tournament, Brazilian athletes guaranteed 40 places for the Olympics. The 2023 season was a warm-up for the 2024 Paris Games.



7.6. FOUR NEW ROWERS JOIN PROLIM

Four rowing athletes, from the lightweight category, join Prolim, the Navy's Olympic Program in November. Rowers Maria Fernanda Nunes (Botafogo), Pedro Xavier (GNU), Marcelo Almeida (Botafogo) and João Ferreira (Vasco) graduated as Third Sergeant of the Institution and are part of the Brazilian military force.

There are eight Brazilian rowers who are part of the military team that is part of Prolim. The four young soldiers join Fernanda Nunes (Vasco), Vangelys Reinke (Flamengo), Uncas Tales (Botafogo) and Lucas Verthein (Botafogo). Rowing names such as Fabiana Beltrame, Diego Nazário and Evaldo Becker have already joined the Navy Program.

Prolim: Due to the great success achieved by Brazil at the Military World Games in Rio 2011 at the London Olympics in 2012, which had a significant contribution from high-performance military athletes incorporated from 2008 onwards as temporary military personnel, the then Commander of the Navy, Admiral of Júlio Soares de Moura Neto Squadron, in a pioneering initiative, made the Navy Olympic Program (Prolim) permanent.

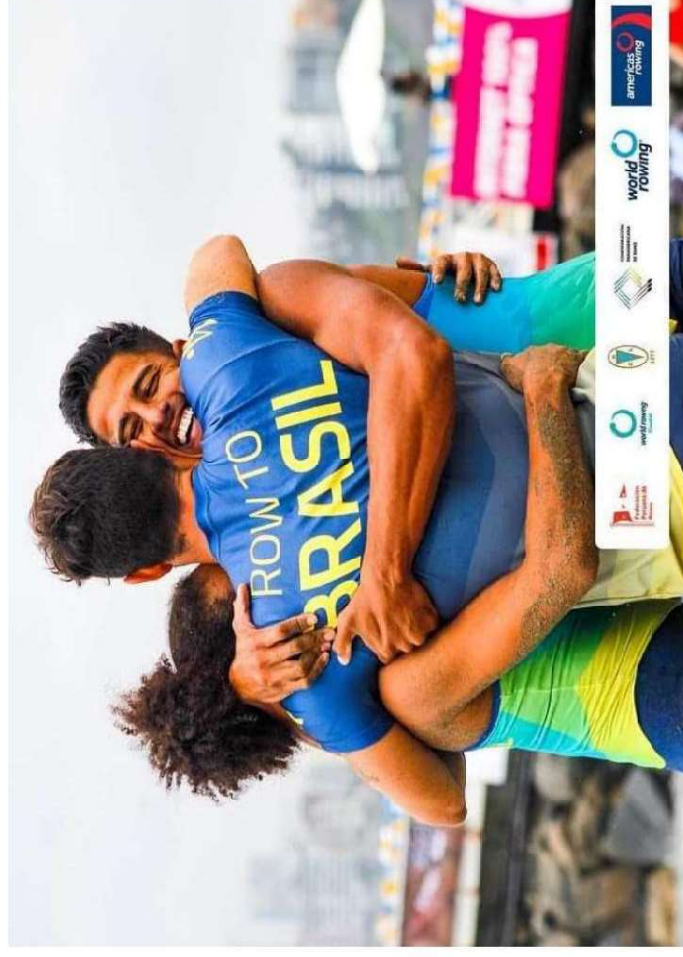
Several sports are included in the Program, rowing being one of them. According to the Brazilian Navy, "the main focus of the Program is the preparation of Brazilian Navy athletes to be part of Brazilian representative teams in Military sports competitions and Brazilian representation in major sporting events of the respective modalities".

Some of Prolim's objectives are to encourage the practice of physical education and sports within the Navy, to attract, through selection and

recruitment of athletes with exceptional performance, to provide them with military-naval training and incorporation into the Navy, aiming to support them technically and financially as high-performance military athletes, contribution to the social inclusion process, through base projects, offering young people from low-income communities have access to quality sports in order to reveal new talents for sports and, above all, support the development of high-performance sports in the Navy.



7.7 COSTAL AT THE LOS ANGELES 2028 GAMES



In anticipation of Paris 2024, the Los Angeles 2028 Games are already arriving with new features for our sport! The International Olympic Committee announces, on Friday the 13th in October, the rowing competition program for the next Olympics.

The news confirms what was already speculated. We will have two types of rowing in Los Angeles 2028! World Rowing states that this is a historic day for the sport, as this edition of the Games will be the

first with two types of paddle!

The inclusion of three Beach Sprint events with the CM1x, CW1x and CMix2x boats and the maintenance of the classic rowing events, as the old Olympic rowing is now being called.

Unfortunately, the women's and men's lightweight doubles are saying goodbye to the Olympic program in Paris 2024. Even with this withdrawal, the number of places and rowing events at the Los Angeles games is increasing.

7.8 SEASON 2023 ENDS WITH POSITIVE BALANCE

In addition to the accounts unanimously approved during the Ordinary General Assembly and the Extraordinary General Assembly, which was attended by all Federation Presidents, held in Florianópolis, Santa Catarina, in April last year, the Administrative Department of the Brazilian Rowing Confederation has lots to celebrate. After all, the 2023 Season was also very positive and full of achievements in terms of Management and Transparency.

GET Program: Prepared by the COB in 2017, the GET is an effective tool for monitoring the administrative work of the Brazilian Sports Confederations, aiming for transparency in administrative processes.

In 2018, the first visits to confederations were carried out to diagnose and monitor actions. In 2019, the program was expanded with actions focused on transparency, ombudsman service and strategic planning. As a result of this joint work, we optimized the GET for 2024. This tool will now consist of 9 areas of knowledge and 336 (three hundred and thirty-six) questions in total, distributed across several areas.

In addition to the questions, the weight of the theme "Participation in Competitions", the metrics for defining the size of Sports Entities and all the categories that the program covers, such as: Governance, Strategy, Transparency and Women in Sports, for example, also were revised for 2024. The GET Program score is one of 12 items evaluated by the COB in the annual distribution of resources to Olympic sports. The main point is that good government practices within the Confederations are of excellent

development to open up opportunities to all areas of socio-economic development of sports entities, through financial contributions from both the private sector and the sphere of federal incentives.

The Brazilian Rowing Confederation has stood out within the program, obtaining higher grades each year. The main objective of GET in confederations is directly linked to good governance practices, ethics and transparency. It is worth highlighting the evolution of the CBR in the last 3 years, always being among the top 5 Olympic confederations: 2021 - 8,20; 2022 - 9,49 and 2023 - 9,69

Maintaining the GET project within the CBR is extremely important for the development of the sport at a national and international level. Good governance, ethics and transparency practices develop and improve processes within society, in the general context. With the implementation of the project, CBR achieved several improvements, such as wide dissemination of social networks, adherence to the program and

certificate of member of the #JOGOLIMPO Membership Program, evolution and adaptation of administrative processes, creation of Ethics Councils and Board of Directors, among other administrative improvements.

Adherence to the #JogoLimpo Program: Certification to the #jogolimp Program is extremely important for the Confederation, this was a project that the entity was pursuing and, last year, it was certified for the first time. The objective is to seek to be among the entities that support good sporting practices and anti-doping policies adopted by the ABCD.

The #JOGOLIMPO Membership Program is an improved strategy of the #jogolimp campaign, aimed at entities that want ABCD certification, attesting to their commitment to Brazil's anti-doping policy. Through this program, any sports administration or practice entity in Brazil can request membership, in addition to other organizations that deal directly or indirectly with sports and have inter-

this is the case.

A-18A Certificates: Federal Government Certification 18 - 18A, which is a mandatory certification for the availability of federal resources. Without this annual certification, we would not be able to receive resources from the COB or any other Federal Government entity.

In order for entities of the National Sports System - SND to receive public resources, as well as to enjoy exemption from IRPJ and CSLL, Law no. 9.615/1998, in

its articles 18 and 18-A, explains the various requirements to be fulfilled by these entities. The Brazilian Federal Revenue also issued Normative Instruction No. 1,700/2017, which links the exemption from some tax rates to compliance with articles 18 and 18-A of Law 9,615/1998.

The good GET grades together with COB, the 18-18a Certificates and adherence to the #JogoLimpo Program are some of the high points obtained by the CBR administrative sector during President Magali Moreira's management in the years she has been at the head of the Confederation.

8.1 SPECIAL WOMEN'S DAY

On this International Women's Day, the Brazilian Rowing Confederation would like to congratulate all the women who make this sport more than just a sport. Dedicated, fierce, competitive, resilient and strong. For - Athletes, high-performance athletes, base and master categories, coaches, referees and managers transform rowing daily with each stroke, decision and perseverance.

Pioneer Rowing: The first Brazilian rowing champion in the single sculls was known during the Brazil Women's and Junior Rowing Trophy, in 1984, at Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas, Dulce D'Ávila Bandeira from GNU climbed to the highest place on the podium. In the same year, the rower was also the first South American rowing champion, in an extra event organized by the CBR as an incentive for women's rowing during the disputed XVII South American Rowing Championship, where the Albano lane system was inaugurated, which in 2016 would host the Olympic Games. Where we were represented by rowers Fernanda Nunes and Vanessa Cozzi, current president of the CBR Athletes Commission.

Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas was once again the stage for Dulce's success and pioneering spirit. The race was named after another Brazilian woman, swimmer Maria Lenk. First woman to represent Brazil, and all of South America, at the Olympic Games.

In the same race, another rower wrote history with her strokes, GPA athlete Marisa de Moraes Lisboa. The rower was the first Brazilian double sculls champion (2x) alongside Claudia Magali Gomes da Silva. Marisa was also the winner of the first Blue Ribbon, a traditional single sculls competition organized by the Speria club in São Paulo, which included women's events in its program.

Marisa was also the first Brazilian woman to represent us abroad, at the Fisa World Cup, now

World Rowing, in 1987. It was the first time that the competition included races in the lightweight category and our athlete was there, once again writing history, or better said: rowing history, participating in the lightweight women's single sculls (1X LW).

Still in 1987, while Marisa de Moraes Lisboa represented us at the World Championships in Hazewinkel, Belgium, athlete Ana Helena Puccetti won her first Blue Ribbon and Brazil Rowing Trophy. The rower, years later, in 1996, would join the four sculls (4x) that would give us our first gold medal in official international competitions, in the South American race of Calao in Peru. Alongside Ana were athletes Patricia Moreno, Renata Gorgen and Claudia Alencar.

The coach of this boat was the South American rowing champion of two senior coxswains (2-) in 1988, Breno Manczek Mello who also coached Dulce D'Ávila Bandeira. Becoming one of the first coaches in the sport who encouraged and believed in women's rowing in the country. "I've always enjoyed coaching women's and youth teams", comments Manczek.

Super Twins Activate! Claudia and Kátia Alencar do not have the same surname by chance, the twin sisters were also pioneers by being the first to represent us in international competitions in team boats and for a long time they dominated the Lagoa and the National Rowing, reaching one of the higher salaries for the Flamengo rowing team. The duo, more than dynamic, were Pan American Water Polo champions, before switching to rowing at the invitation of Guilherme Augusto do Eirado Silva, known as Buck.

The only competition that Kátia and Claudia don't compete in

classified were the Olympic Games. Made by Fabiana Beltrame. The athlete qualified in the single sculls (1x) for the 2004 Olympics in Athens, repeating the feat in 2008 and 2012. Fabiana was also the first Brazilian to reach the podium at the Pan American Games, winning two silver medals in different editions, in 2011 and 2015. As if that wasn't enough, the athlete from Santa Catarina was also the first to bring us a gold medal in World Cups and World Cups, in 2011.

The para-rowing that doesn't stop: When the Paralympic rowing modality began, two women stood out on the national scene and in the Brazilian team for their results.

Claudia Cicero, known as Claudinha, from Pinheiros, brought the first gold medal in the sport in the single sculls PR1 (1x PR1), at the World Championships held in Germany. It was the rower's first participation in international competitions,

The first Brazilian rowing medal at the Games

The Paralympics was won in a mixed boat with athlete Josiane Lima in the PR2 mixed double sculls (2xPR2 Mix), alongside Elton Santana. Brazilian athletes took bronze, the first time the sport was part of the Paralympic program, in the Beijing edition, in 2008. Josi, as she is better known, rows for Aldo Luz.

A few years later, the first two-time world rowing champion in the history of Brazilian sport would come from para-rowing, Diana Barcelos, from Flamengo, in the double sculls Misto PR3 (2x MixPR3). Alongside Paulista Jairo Klug, from Pinheiros, Diana climbed to the highest place on the podium. Promising for the Paris Games next year, the athlete has been highlighted and consolidated on the Brazilian scene as one of the main athletes in the PR3 category.

Meanwhile in Ribeira... Going back in time a little, again to the 90s, to tell the story of the first rowing athlete from Bahia who won the Brazilian Championship, Copa Norte Nordeste and became part of the Brazilian Rowing Team, representing us in Games South Americans.

Marilene Silva Barbosa, Mary. "I remember I had to beg so I could row. The directors didn't want to let women row. After my first victory, no one doubted me anymore and I was able to row", comments Marilene.

But Marilene's pioneering spirit goes far beyond the 2000 meter course of each race. Our athlete became the first woman to lead and coach a rowing team throughout the North Northeast, at the Clube de Regatas São Salvador, becoming champion of the North Northeast Rowing Cup in her events and for the team as well, but the coach want more! "My dream is to see one of my athletes in the Brazilian team", says Mary bluntly.



They are the owners of the bo... boats? In addition to Marilene from São Salvador, today we have other women team coaches. Like Vanessa Varga from São Paulo, the first to lead a rowing team in the country. "I had to stop rowing and I was very sad, I missed it a lot. I studied Physical Education to work with rowing, I love the sport! My father was against it, but I told him I was going to be the first coach of rowing in Brazil", says Vanessa.



The Remo4 coach, Manuela Marsilli, dreams of working on a project to develop female rowing athletes.

"Developing a welcoming and healthy environment for beginner rowers is my biggest motivation for working in rowing", comments the coach from Rio Grande do Sul.

Manuela's dream grows when more women stand out on the national and international scene, like coach Leticia Muziol, who is part of WISH (Women in

Sport High-performance pathway programme), a program that encourages, educates and teaches, in partnership with World Rowing, women

trainers from all over the world, in a course that lasts 21 months with various activities, classes and lectures. Along with the Brazilian, three other foreign coaches joined the program last year.

Thanks to coaches Vanessa Varga, Marilene Silva Barbosa, Manuela Marsilli dos Santos, Leticia Muziol de Oliveira, Thaina Korpalski, Rita de Cassia Carvalho de Andrade, Marcela Sacramento Santos and Karina Lima are the pioneering coaches of Brazilian rowing, leading teams and changing perceptions of Rowing as a sport.

Pay attention to the Rules! While Marilene dominated the rowing events in Ribeira, another woman began her story as a referee. Magali Moreira was the second Brazilian woman to obtain a CSAR license and become President of the Federation of Regatas Clubs of Bahia. As arbitration coordinator, she trained dozens of arbitrators across the country, changing the conception and scenario of arbitration in Brazil.

Still as arbitration coordinator, in 2007, Magali Moreira became a World Rowing referee, Performing in World Cups and the Tokyo Olympics. In addition to having worked in the organization at the Rio de Janeiro Olympic and Paralympic Games in 2016.

It was no coincidence that during its coordination the country had its first female referees who obtained the World Rowing license in the history of Brazilian rowing. It is worth noting that Brazil is the only country to have more female World Rowing referees than men in the world.

A positive point for Brazilian rowing, as women in World Rowing represent only 24% of the entity's refereeing staff in the world.

Other women should also be remembered on this day, they are the rowing directors, secretaries and administrative staff who make the sport work so that our athletes' rows can happen.

Rowing is more than just a sport, it is a team effort. We pay tribute to all administrative employees of national and state rowing, through Marisa Braga, who has worked at the Brazilian Rowing Confederation for 21 years as the institution's secretary and is part of the Paralympic Rowing team, supporting the Technical Commission and intermediating our contact with the CPB.

Years later, Magali Moreira became the first woman to be elected president of the CBR. Taking place in 2021 at the first CBI of Rowing with the gender equal events program, that is, the same number of women's and men's events. Doubling the number of rowers registered in the competition and encouraging the sport of rowing in Brazil, breaking the record for female registrations in the history of the Brazilian Championships.

Attention, Go! Following in the footsteps of Magali Moreira and other pioneering women in their states, the Presidents of Remosul, Ana Valeska Hoerlle and FRB, Lilia de Oliveira lead the rowing in front of the State Federations of Rio Grande do Sul and Brasilia.

The two presidents, in addition to organizing and encouraging rowing from Rio Grande do Sul and Brasilia, being in charge of the State Championships, are also athletes in the masters category and rowing referees. Representing their states inside and outside the rowing lanes.

8.2 PINK OCTOBER SPECIAL

In this special month, we had the privilege of telling the story of a Brazilian woman who faced prejudice, stigma and beat breast cancer, because the disease has a cure! The Brazilian and Gaucho, was president of RемоSul for two terms, current director of CR Vasco da Gama- RS master rower, rowing referee and volleyball athlete,

Ana Valesca Hoerlle.

The then volleyball player and recent graduate, Ana Valesca, discovered rowing through the Faculty of Physical Education and her first job was at GNU during the 90s. Years later, in 2011, as a result of a routine mammogram, she discovered cancer breast feeding and then a new cycle began, a battle for her own life.

"I didn't stop working at any point, only on the days of chemotherapy and two days after the sessions. I didn't want people to know I was sick, because I didn't want anyone feeling sorry for me. Right at the beginning of chemotherapy I found a wig like that to my hair and moved on", recalls Ana.

The director highlights the importance of mammography and routine exams for women's health. "My cancer was very internal, I wouldn't have discovered it with self-examination alone. Annual exams are extremely important," explains the referee.

Ana Valesca underwent chemotherapy sessions, surgery to remove the tumor and five years of oral chemotherapy to prevent the return of breast cancer. Today, Ana is cancer-free and continues her active life! Just the way she likes it!

"I remember that I went back to training and competing the moment the chemo ended! I was really scared that my wig would fall off in the middle of the games, but I was going to fight! I confess that throughout my journey with the treatment, the only The first time I cried was when my hair started falling out because you

I hope it won't happen.", says the athlete.

Ana Valesca, while she was in charge of Remosul, held a regatta every October to draw attention to the fact that breast cancer has a cure.

For those who are facing the disease now, the rowing referee has some advice: "Don't be alone, don't isolate yourself. Keep your spirits high, it's very important to never get discouraged! Don't feel sorry for yourself. Always put on some music when if you're at home, don't lose your vanity, everything will pass. This phase will pass too", advises the victorious Ana.

Twelve years later it is a fact that Ana Valesca beat breast cancer and despite being discreet with her story, the leader always holds events, whether in rowing, volleyball or at the State Secretariat where she works, to raise awareness that breast cancer There is a cure for breast cancer and the importance of mammography for women's health. You have to do it once a year!

8.3 OLYMPIC CHANNEL BROADCAST : THREE TIMES ROWING

The 2023 season was marked by a partnership with Canal Olimpico do Brasil, the Brazilian Olympic Committee's streaming channel, where rowing competitions were the stars of the program three times. The first was in the Pre-Pan American Rowing, a qualifying event for Santiago 2023. The Brazilian team won one silver and two bronze medals and the semifinals and finals were broadcast live so that the public could follow the events and performances of our athletes straight from Laguna Grande.

The comments were made by then newcomer Tiago Almeida, known as Capi.

A veteran of rowing, our Pan-American medalist and Olympic athlete, currently coach of Riachuelo, took on not only the risk, but the challenge of commenting, live, on the events and performances not only of Brazilian athletes, but also of other teams competition participants.

The second event was the Unified Rowing CBI, where the Canal Olimpico team broadcast the three days of finals, showing all the determination of our athletes defending the colors of their clubs and always seeking the highest place on the podium. The comments were made by world medalist and also Olympic athlete Willian Giarretton, known as Magrao.

The third competition broadcast was not just a rowing event, but The Pan American Games of Santiago 2023. All days of competition were broadcast and all events could be watched by the Brazilian public who followed

each stroke, live, directly from Laguna Grande.

The year 2023 marked important achievements for the Brazilian Olympic Channel. The Brazilian Olympic Committee's streaming, in operational partnership with NSports, reached unprecedented levels of coverage and live transmission of national and international competitions. The biggest highlight was the historic exhibition of the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, in which the Olympic Channel was the main Brazilian broadcast channel.

For the first time in its history, the Brazilian Olympic Channel broadcast a competition of the magnitude of the Pan American Games, considered the second largest multi-sport competition in the world and the largest in the Americas. Thanks to this partnership, the Brazilian public can watch live the unprecedented gold medal in the men's single sculls by Lucas Vertheim and the silver medal by Bia Tavares, also in the single sculls, but in the women's category.

8.4 HALL OF FAME SPECIAL - FATHER'S DAY

When young Arnaldo Brant decided to visit his family, who had recently moved to Rio de Janeiro, he did not imagine that between going back and forth between Minas Gerais and the Capital of Rio de Janeiro he would find not one, but two loves of his life: his future wife and Remo. The love for his wife gave him his only daughter: Claudia Marina Brant and the love for rowing also multiplied and lasted for generations.

Systematically, even working and studying, Arnaldo cultivated memories, victories and friends in sport. He built a career that inspired athletes, colleagues and opponents. Calm, quiet and methodical, this was the athlete who studied Physical Education, after graduating in Law, became a coach and sought to develop not only training centers and athletes, but was one of the first to raise the flag for Women's Rowing in the country.

First rows: According to one of the numerous athletes trained by Arnaldo, José Luiz Emerim, the then aspiring rower, recently arrived from Minas Gerais, learned to row in Guanabara through his brother Mário, who was older. Out of youthful curiosity, they both went to learn about rowing. The brother didn't stay, but Arnaldo did.

Young Arnaldo married very early and almost immediately, the couple had their only daughter, Claudia Marina who, years later, would be one of the pioneer rowers in Rio rowing. Taking on a great responsibility, even at his young age, 20 years old, the then Rower worked full time at the Regional Labor Court and still trained.

Rio de Janeiro and Brazilian champion, Arnaldo never represented the Brazilian team and yet, yes, he is one of the best-known names, influencing dozens of athletes who went through his career as a rower or coach.

The Mentor and Coach: When he retired the oars,

Arnaldo could have stayed away from the sport, instead, he invested in knowledge and returned to the University to graduate in Physical Education. Becoming coach of several clubs such as Flamengo, Vasco, Botafogo, GNU and the Brazilian team, without ever leaving his job at the Court.

Accustomed to double shifts, Arnaldo Brant was Paulo Cesar Dworakowski's coach for almost a decade. "I trained with Arnaldo for 9 years... The initial 2 years as a junior at União and the other 7 at Botafogo. I can say that we had 9 years of success in competitions thanks to his engagement as a coach, mentor and mediator between directors, managers, sponsors in order to create a productive work environment with me.

Above all, I learned from him the dignity and pride of being able to face the "beasts of Flamengo", a club that at that time recruited the best rowers. I was asked to transfer many times, but it was with Arnaldo's integrity that I developed self-esteem and a lot of mental strength to deal with difficulties in sport and in life. I remember that in 80, before the Olympics, we were in Bañolas at a training camp and he came out with this: "Paulo, you demand a lot from people." He spoke little, but was always aware when I tended to extremes.

I left Brazil in 81 when I no longer counted on it for my plans for the future. It was with mutual respect and almost without words, but with smiles of satisfaction, pride and camaraderie that we said goodbye", recalls Paulo Cesar, our representative at the Moscow Olympic Games.

But Arnaldo would expand his goals, after going to Germany to study and improve as a coach, together with Edgard Knerim, known as Pavão, who was runner-up in the Pan-American Championship in 1963 and three-time Rio de Janeiro champion as coach of Botafogo years later.

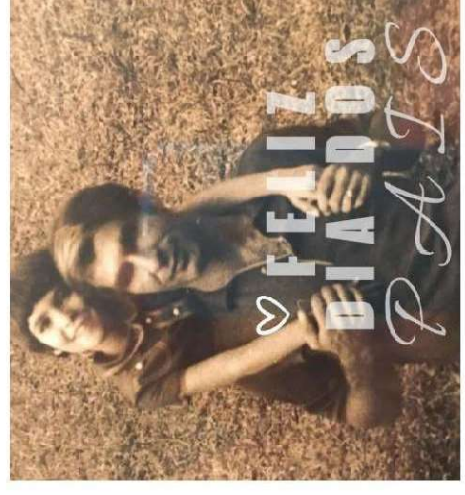

of São Paulo in 2005, that we won everything? Dad was one of the coaches", Claudia says proudly.

After becoming Rio Grande do Sul champion, it was alongside Jaqueline Xavier that she became two-time Brazilian champion and dreamed of a place in the first Pan-American tournament that would have women's events in 1987. As her dream was cut short by internal policies and she was not even able to go compete for the index, Claudia then retired.

Despite a difficult history, which was also marked by her father's companionship, Claudia never left the sport and claims that her entire experience in rowing helped shape her character and know how to fight for her place and assert herself. "Rowing is my love. I love the sport. This whole experience taught me a lot of things that I take with me to this day", says the emotional athlete, who currently rows masters for Piraquê.

Arnaldo Brant, after his time at CBR, left Rowing and returned to his studies, passing the competition for Judge at the Regional Labor Court, where he retired. In 2019, Arnaldo, unfortunately, passed away, but left a legacy of knowledge and love for his athletes and family.



In 1982, Claudia Brant was the first Rio champion in a race at the state of Rio de Janeiro against athletes in Boqueirão do Passeio in a 4-sided role. "It wasn't easy. The sea clubs (in the 80s, some clubs in Rio would have their headquarters in Praia de Botafogo) joined the idea. When Santa Luiza closed, the athletes went to Botafogo and we trained together.

Some clubs did not want to accept the idea that women's rowing was possible. Even so, Dad supported leaders and managed to win some battles. I remember that I had to hide to change my clothes because no club had a women's bathroom at the time", recalls Claudia Brant.

From father to daughter: Inspired by her father, Claudia Marina Brant, followed in Arnaldo's footsteps in Remo. One of the pioneering women of the sport in Brazil, champion from Rio, Rio Grande do Sul and two-time Brazilian champion. "My father had to ask some managers and directors at clubs like Botafogo to implement Women's Rowing. I was sometimes insulted during my training in Lagoa by people passing by. It was never easy, I remember that the Vasco board didn't I wanted to allow women to row at the club, the then president of the CBR left the Confederation garage at my disposal to store my boat there", says Claudia.

The Carioca Champion moved with her father to Rio Grande do Sul when Arnaldo took over União for the second time. The rower says that it was at GNU that she felt part of a team and got to live in the club's accommodation. At that time, he went home for lunch, rowing the single skiff a few times.

After leaving GNU, Brant continued trying to open the long-awaited high-performance center and even joined the Technical Committee of the Brazilian National Team in the early 2000s. "Remember that South American

8.5 COVERAGE OF ALL STATES

One of the highlights of CBR's communication during the 2023 season was the coverage of the Brazilian state championships. Space given to Federations to showcase their championships on the Remo Brasil website and social media.

Throughout the year, there were more than thirty articles published on the CBR website and collaborations on social networks to publicize the profiles of state entities. In 2024, CBR intends to expand this statewide coverage, seeking to meet different demands so that sport in the states showcases its news, strengths and peculiarities.

During the 2023 season, all state champions had guaranteed space on Remo Brasil's social networks. Collaborations were made between clubs and state federations, seeking to publicize the work done and the organization of the regattas, giving support and visibility to state entities.

The expansion of social networks, such as the number of followers of each profile of the Federations and Confederation, is extremely important, as Instagram is one of the most used digital platforms in the world and is a space used by several sports entities and companies. all kinds. Increasing the visibility of the sport in a space with such a diverse and young audience is one of the opportunities to promote rowing and gain more audiences, consequently, in traditional media and also a tool for seeking sponsorship and partnerships.

We ended the 2023 season with more than 9 thousand followers and the intention is to reach 10 thousand followers during the 2024 season, passing the mark by the end of the year. This will mean that we double the number of followers in less than two years.

O risco de não detecção de distorção relevante resultante de fraude é maior do que o proveniente de erro, já que a fraude pode envolver o ato de burlar os controles internos, conluio, falsificação, omissão ou representações falsas intencionais.

- Obtemos entendimento dos controles internos relevantes para a auditoria para planejamos procedimentos de auditoria apropriados às circunstâncias, mas, não, com o objetivo de expressarmos opinião sobre a eficácia dos controles internos da Entidade.

- Avaliamos a adequação das políticas contábeis utilizadas e a razoabilidade das estimativas contábeis e respectivas divulgações feitas pela administração.

- Concluímos sobre a adequação do uso, pela administração, da base contábil de continuidade operacional e, com base nas evidências de auditoria obtidas, se existe incerteza relevante em relação a eventos ou condições que possam levantar dúvida significativa em relação à capacidade de continuidade operacional da Entidade. Se concluirmos que existe incerteza relevante, devemos chamar atenção em nosso relatório de auditoria para as respectivas divulgações nas demonstrações contábeis ou incluir modificação em nossa opinião, se as divulgações forem inadequadas. Nossas conclusões estão fundamentadas nas evidências de auditoria obtidas até a data de nosso relatório. Todavia, eventos ou condições futuras podem levar a Entidade a não mais se manter em continuidade operacional.

- Avaliamos a apresentação geral, a estrutura e o conteúdo das demonstrações contábeis, inclusive as divulgações e se as demonstrações contábeis representam as correspondentes transações e os eventos de maneira compatível com o objetivo de apresentação adequada.

Comunicamos com os responsáveis pela governança a respeito, entre outros aspectos, do alcance planejado, da época da auditoria e das constatações significativas de auditoria, inclusive as eventuais deficiências significativas nos controles internos que identificamos durante nossos trabalhos.

Fornecemos também aos responsáveis pela governança declaração de que cumprimos com as exigências éticas relevantes, incluindo os requisitos aplicáveis da independência, e comunicamos todos os eventuais relacionamentos ou assuntos que poderiam afetar, consideravelmente, nossa independência, incluindo quando aplicável, as respectivas salvaguardas.

Cercando-se este Conselho Fiscal da documentação apresentada, passou-se a apresentar o Resumo Comparativo das Demonstrações Exercício 2023, acordando ao final por apresentar as NOTAS EXPLICATIVAS AS DEMONSTRAÇÕES CONTÁBEIS ENCERRADAS em 31 de dezembro de 2023.

Em que pese este Conselho lastrear-se na documentação, acima referida, cumpre alertar que o Relatório dos Auditores Independentes sobre as Demonstrações financeiras - Exercício Findo em 31/12/2023, extensamente referenciado na análise, deverá fazer parte do presente parecer.

Não poderíamos deixar de registrar que, para uma melhor comparação e análise dos saldos apresentados, decidiu este Conselho por manter os valores auditáveis no final do exercício de 2021, na presente análise.
